



## University Requirements

- Entry Level Writing (ELW) Required for admission as a transfer student, this should be completed
- American History & Institutions Probably already completed
- 2.0 GPA
- Minimum 180 quarter units Only 70 semester units (105 quarter units) can be transferred from a community college
- General Education Classes IGETC fulfills most of these Categories I – VIII

Other Requirements

**American History and Institutions** (may be met in several ways): Most students have satisfied this requirement with high school work. International students, see a counselor for information on how to satisfy the requirement.

#### **Residence requirement**

At least 36 of the final 45 units completed by a student for the bachelor's degree must be earned in residence at the UCI campus.

#### Normal progress toward degree

Must follow the program of study required for your major and graduate when done (normally in two years).

Grade Requirement

## Minimum grade point average of at least 'C' (2.0) is required:

- 1. Overall
- 2. In all of the courses required for and offered in the major program
- 3. In the upper-division courses required for and offered in the major program

In any given quarter, if all three of these requirements are not met, you may be subject to probation or disqualification. If your quarterly GPA falls below 2.0, you may be subject to probation or disqualification.
